Village Permits: Village permits are required for additions or alterations to existing structures and new construction as well as for the replacement or erection of fences or the siting of dumpsters. Please refer to the Village regulations for details and contact the Village Office (301-654-7084) with any questions. Permit forms are available from the Village office. .

Tax Time Reminder: Village residents who file their State tax return should not forget to include the Village as your “city” on your return. **See Page 4.** The State Comptroller's Office has discovered errors in coding revenue to the towns and villages of Montgomery County over many years, so this information is most important.

BULK TRASH PICKUP: Bulk trash pick up will be **Saturday, March 17th**. Items must be at curbside by 7 AM. Our contractor uses different trucks to haul different items, so do not be alarmed if certain items are removed before others. Please contact You Call We Haul, Inc. at 301-605-0140 if you wish to dispose of a refrigerator, freezer or air conditioner.

Bulk trash includes: Washing machines, dryers, stoves, hot water heaters, other major appliances, furniture or parts of furniture, large toys, bicycles, wing sets, bath tubs, sinks, toilets, do-it-yourself amounts of earth, sand, gravel, demolition debris and construction waste, parts of automobiles, but not fleet tires.

Excluded are: Large tree stumps, poisons, acids, caustics, explosives, oil or other flammable liquids, motor vehicles and parts such as batteries and tires, bricks and general construction material, iron pipe over 10 ft. long, large rocks, wood piles, large tree limbs, dead animals, human or animal feces and ammunition.

2019 Budget: Work on the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget has begun. Any proposals for changes, additions or reductions to the new budget are welcomed by the Village Council. This should be another challenging year, since the Village, the County and the State are facing possible impacts from the *Wynne vs. Maryland* case. Recycle Old Cell Phones: Old cell phones **with** their chargers can be dropped off at the Communications Center at Chevy Chase Village Hall for recycling to victims of domestic violence or senior citizens. The phones are wiped clean of any service, phone numbers or address book entries and then reprogrammed for the persons mentioned above so they may call 911 to report an emergency situation. They cannot be used for any other function.
